AFNOR (Association Française de Normalisation) is, according to the 2009 decree on standardisation (reference to be specified), the operator in France responsible for guiding and coordinating the drafting of national standardisation documents and France's participation in the drafting of European and international standardisation documents. In particular, the association ensures the programming of standardisation work on the basis of the identification of needs identified by the economic and social partners and the contributions of the standardisation offices.

Voluntary standards create favourable conditions for sharing and developing new products and services and act as innovation accelerators. Standardization is both a powerful tool for making optimal use of research and a vector for disseminating innovation. Used upstream of innovation as a tool for economic intelligence, voluntary standardization makes it possible to detect changes demanded by civil society players and therefore to guide technical choices in research and development and to develop new concepts. Standardization can therefore, in this sense, foster the emergence of innovation.

AFNOR is recognized as a major player in metal and mineral standardization at national, European and international level. AFNOR is in charge of the secretariats of ISO/TC 155 "Nickel and its alloys" and ISO/TC 79 "Light metals" (aluminum, magnesium and titanium). The aim is to develop technical standards in support of international trade (ISO standards are recognized by the WTO). On a national level, AFNOR is in charge of the national platform for the standardization of specialty metals and minerals. This momentum continues with the preparation of an international technical committee on specialty minerals (antimony, cobalt, graphite, indium, etc.).



AFNOR's expertise is well knowned in steering the development of a document by consensus. AFNOR is experienced since 1926 in publishing and drafting standards and standardization documents. Hence, AFNOR keeps its neutrality in relation to the various stakeholders and the subject under consideration.
